1. Continuing or transfer student with junior or senior standing, recognized by Seattle University, in a College of Science and Engineering major by fall quarter 2020.

2. Full-time major in the College of Science and Engineering for the duration of the scholarship.

3. GPA of 3.5 or higher for previous college-level work.

4. Record of campus involvement and community service, and acommitment to participate in the Bannan Scholars Enrichment Program.

Note:

- Sullivan and Naef Scholars are not eligible.
- Post-Baccalaureate, fifth year and graduate students are not eligible.

- Both domestic and international students may apply.
