




View your Transfer Credit Evaluation


- Awards are typically available 2-3 weeks after your admission offer




Confirm Your Enrollment

*If approved, your application will go through the review process again. Your merit scholarship amount could be different than what you were originally awarded when you were admitted. We will need updated transcripts if you take any additional courses





Pay your Enrollment Deposit

NOTE: Required for Fall Quarter start ONLY


- We are excited to welcome you to the SU community!
- Students attending Seattle University in *Summer, Winter or Spring Quarter* are **not required** to pay an enrollment deposit
- To officially confirm your enrollment for *Fall Quarter*, you need to pay a \$200 enrollment deposit, which you can do by completing an Enrollment Deposit Form
- This amount is an early payment that goes directly towards paying your tuition
- Exceptions to the enrollment deposit requirement are occasionally made for students with *significant* financial need, please contact us about waiver options
- Deposit refunds are available through **August 1st**












Redhawk Essentials Checklist


