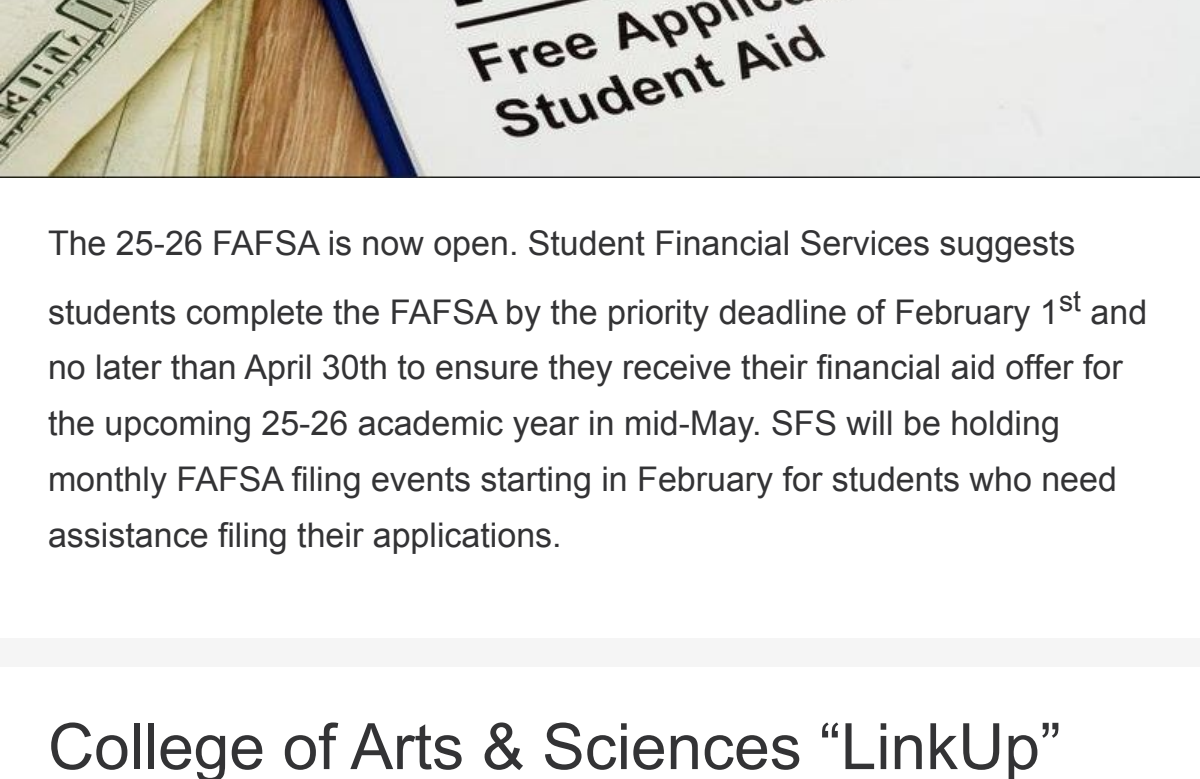

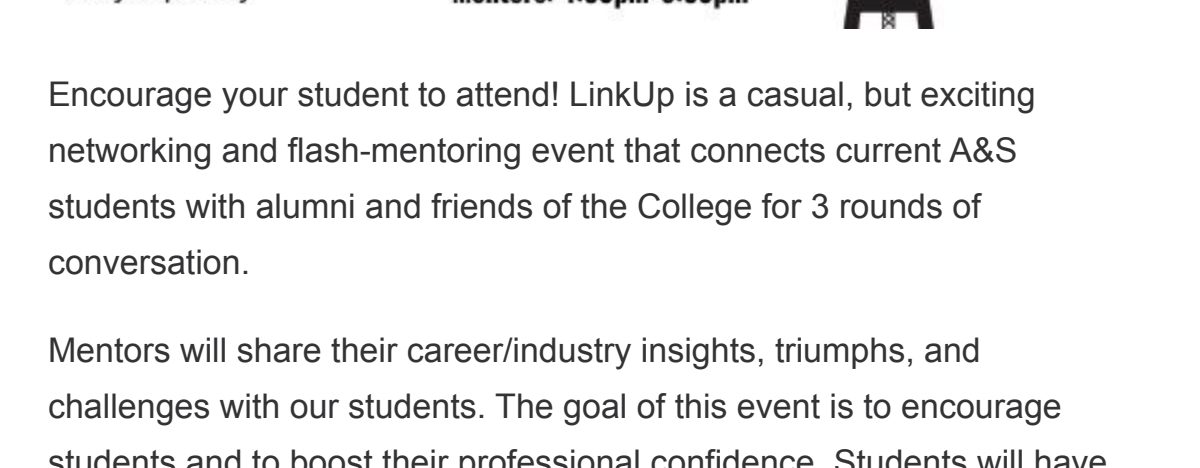

Student Financial Services suggests students complete the FAFSA by the priority deadline of February 1<sup>st</sup> and no later than April 30th to ensure they receive their financial aid offer for the upcoming 25-26 academic year in mid-May. SFS will be holding monthly FAFSA filing events starting in February for students who need assistance filing their applications.

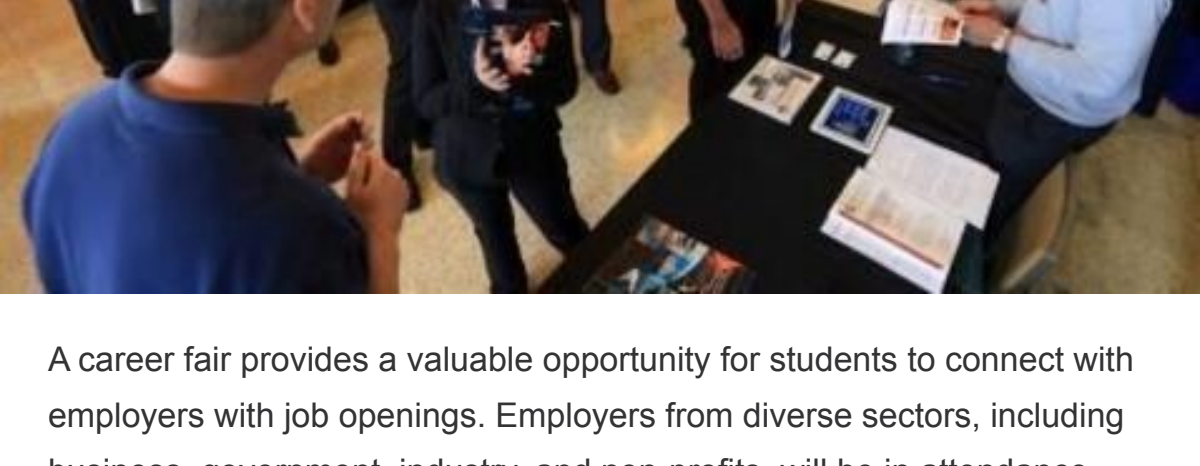
Focused on College of Arts and Sciences students, but all SU students are welcome to participate.

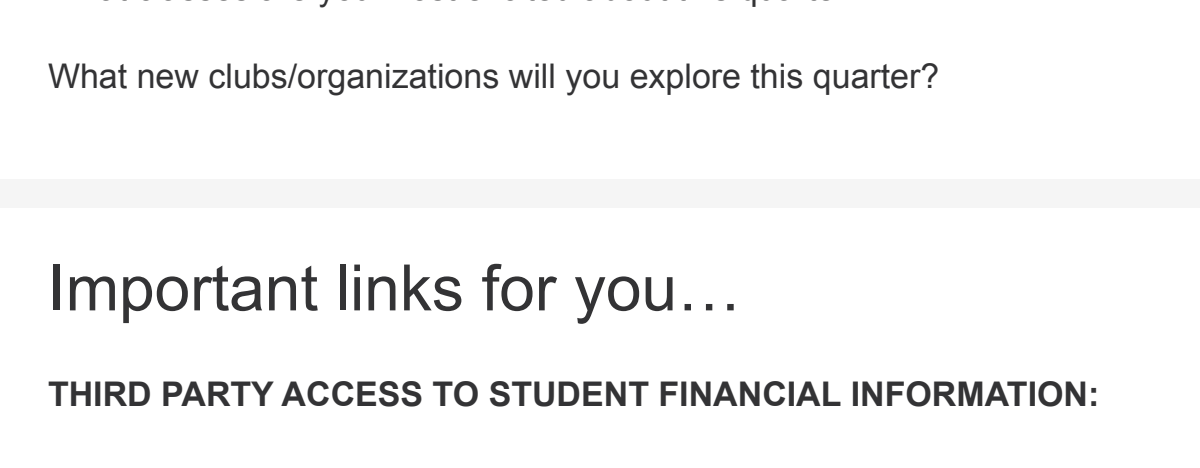
## Winter Career & Internship Fair, 2/6



A career fair provides a valuable opportunity for students to connect with employers with job openings. Employers from diverse sectors, including business, government, industry, and non-profits, will be in attendance.

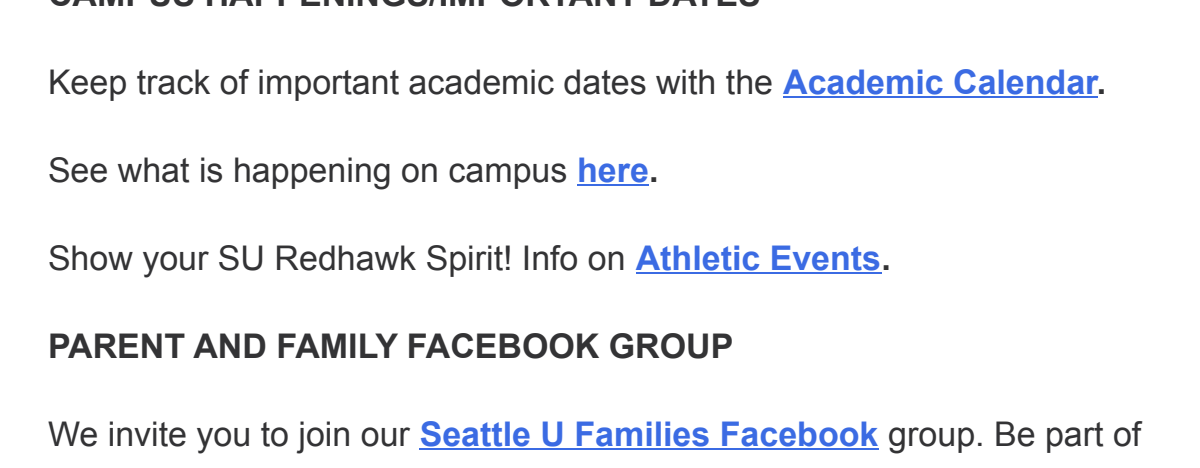

### THIRD PARTY ACCESS TO STUDENT FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

There are two types of suggested access that students may give to parents or supporters.

**Proxy Access** allows family/supporter to speak to SFS Office about account status, balance, award letter, and required documentation.

**Authorized User Access** allows family/supporter login access view billing and payment information, setup payment plans, see tax documents, and get email notifications about billing invoicing.
