Medical Treatment of Minor Students

The Seattle University Student Health Center ("SU SHC") is an on-campus medical care resource available to students during their enrollment at Seattle University. The SU SHC offers outpatient care for a range of care frequently needed by college aged students.

When a patient under the age of 18 years old who is a student enrolled at SU seeks care at the SU SHC, we usually need consent from a parent or legal guardian prior to providing the care. Under Washington state law, the following circumstances allow for care under the age of 18 without parental/guardian consent:

- Emergency medical services
- Reproductive health care and sexually transmitted disease testing/treatment (including HIV)
- Outpatient substance abuse treatment
- Mental health treatment

Authorization for Care and Treatment

- I authorize the Seattle University Student Health Center to provide medical treatment to the patient named above.
- I understand that this authorization will be in effect until the patient reaches the age of 18.

Financial Agreement

- I agree to pay Seattle University Student Health Center for all office visit fees, lab fees, and/or other medical charges or services.
